



SB #23/24-03: Paint the Town Red

Be it enacted in accordance with the provisions found in the SUUSA Constitution (SUU Policy 11.1) (IV) (D) (11) concerning the proposal of budgetary allocations during the Summer Semester:

1. *Section 1: Purpose:*

- a. The purpose of this bill is to provide resources for the SUUSA Senate to use during SUU's annual Paint the Town Red on September 1st 2023.

2. *Section 2: The Student Senate finds:*

- a. The following resources, if appropriated by the SUU Student Senate, will increase the student enjoyment and increase student connection for those attending the Paint the Town Red event through incentivizing engagement in fun activities at said event. The materials needed for the activity will be the following:

1. One (1) polarized camera: \$78.00 (without tax);
2. Five (5) cases of water: \$32.16 (without tax);
3. Four (4) bags of Tootsie Roll (Tootsie Frooties): \$15.92 (without tax);
4. One (1) A-frame: \$21.00;

TOTALING: \$147.08 (without tax)


3. *Section 3: Action(s) and implementation:*
