WHEREAS: The Governing Bylaws of SUUSA are central governing documents of SUUSA Student Government and its associated efforts;

WHEREAS: In recent years, the Governing Bylaws and associated governing documents have become continuously more fragmented, outdated, and inaccessible with time; WHEREAS: Other University student associations and their governing bylaws and associated governing documents often keep a compiled set of governing bylaws; WHEREAS: The Governing Bylaws of SUUSA ought to be up to date, readily accessible, and available in the form of one set document to allow for better transparency and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SOUTHERN UTAH UNIVERSITY STUDENT ASSOCIATION THAT:

- Section 1: The Judicial Vice President and the Judicial Council ought to compile
 and then compose the various Governing Bylaws and governing documents into
 one set of bylaws to be presented as a legislative bill to the Student Senate
 within the period of one month.
- 2. Section 2: The Judicial Vice President and the Judicial Council shall find areas of

- the Governing Bylaws to bring up to date as well as to find and propose general improvements to.
- 3. Section 3: The Judicial Vice President and Judicial Council ought to publish the new compilation of Governing Bylaws to the SUUSA website if the Student Senate approves said Governing Bylaws.
- 4. Section 4: The Senate Parliamentarian and Senate Assistant shall be in charge of ensuring that a copy/or copies of this resolution be addressed and sent to:
 - a. The SUUSA Judicial Council.
