The Cedar City Chapter of the Sons of Utah Pioneers will award scholarships varying from \$500 to \$2,000 according to the number of scholarships awarded and combability to Sons of Utah Pioneer's mission.

- 1. Attend an Iron County area school: i.e., Canyon View High School, Cedar City High School, Parowan High School, a charter school, or a home school in Iron County.
- 2. Be admitted to an institution of higher learning that matches and supports the educational goals of the applicant.
- 3. Submit one letter of recommendation from a family member demonstrating character and service to family or community. (Grandparent, parent, guardian, uncle or aunt)
- 4. Submit two letters from nonrelatives demonstrating outstanding character, service and scholarship.
- 5. Submit self description of evidence of community and school service.
- 6. Write and submit an essay with maximum of six hundred words, of a historical person, event or ancestor that has impacted Utah.
- If the winning applicant plans to serve a mission, enter military service, or delay enteringcollege for another SUP board-approved reason, the scholarship will be held for a maximum of two years.
- 8. Scholarship recipients will be asked to make a short presentation to SUP members during or following their first year of higher education.
- 9. Applications must include a self-introductory letter that includes applicant's permanent contact information: address, phone number, and email address.
