

# ESCEM School of Business Management- Double Degree Program Requirements

---

- Students must pursue two academic semesters at ESCEM and take 60 ECTS credits
- Course work will be chosen from major requirements and electives as determined by SUU
- It is mandatory for SUU students, while at ESCEM, to take French as a Foreign Language
- Students have to follow a work placement of min. 100 working days (normally one semester) in a company in the area of International Business, Marketing, or Finance. Students are responsible for finding this work placement either in France, the USA, or any other country
- Students in the double degree program will have to write and present a final thesis that will be supervised and assessed by SUU professors and recognized by ESCEM
- Students will pay tuition and fees to SUU only, and may use any scholarships or financial aid they receive
- ESCEM will assist students in finding housing and other related matters during the study abroad period, but it is the responsibility of students to arrange for their own housing
- Students will be responsible for housing, transportation, food, and all other personal expenses while abroad
- Students must have health insurance while abroad. SUU's Office of International Outreach can assist with this if needed
- Upon graduating from SUU, when all program requirements have been met, students will receive a Bachelor of Arts in European Business Studies in addition to their SUU degree

## Application requirements:

- Completed 60 credit hours and the pre-business core. Must have a letter from College of Business advisor Paula Alger stating that all the pre-requisites will be completed before the applicant's first semester at ESCEM
- Have a GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Application process for both SUU and ESCEM must be completed five months before the study abroad begins
- Only five students will be selected for the program each year
