

SUU Facilities receive excellent rating from state

The Facilities Management team at Southern Utah University, known for many years as Plant Operations, has just received its second straight outstanding score on a facilities audit by the State of Utah.

The State of Utah's Division of Facilities Construction and Management (DFCM) recently completed a Facility Preventive Maintenance Audit at SUU and gave the Cedar City campus a 96 percent score.

this campus both in physical facilities and facility related programs," **Wayne Smith**, Preventive Maintenance Coordinator for DFCM, says. He adds, "Overall, the facility is in very good condition.

"The facilities planning office... has developed a state of the art facility identification system which

is based upon aerial photos and GPS coordinates...This information has been disseminated to the fire department for security and emergency preparedness.

"This is the most sophisticated and comprehensive program for facility management that I have seen in the state."
