

Scholarship Jubilee II breaks record

On September 11, 2004, Southern Utah University hosted the second annual SUU Scholarship Jubilee including a gourmet dinner, auction and concert. This year's Scholarship Jubilee surpassed the funds raised at the first Jubilee by 16% for a total of \$93,000. All of the \$125 dinner tickets were sold while the Osmonds Second Generation wowed a large crowd at the Heritage Center Theater with music spanning several decades beginning with the 50's.

All Jubilee II proceeds benefit the SUU General Academic Scholarship Fund. This means that many more SUU students will receive scholarship funds than could otherwise be possible, thanks to the marvelous support of SUU alumni and friends attending the Jubilee.
