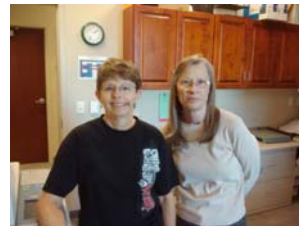


Courses and programs are offered for individuals and professional learning communities. Practical and relevant course work with rigorous standards is delivered fall, spring and summer

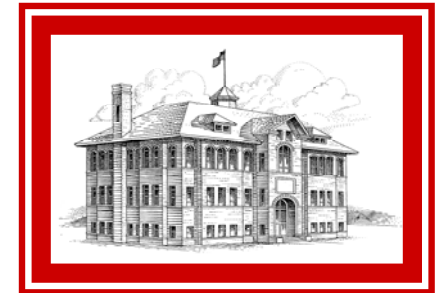

The Leadership in Education and Administrative Development (LEAD) program has two options:

- 2. If you do not have a Master's, you can earn an M.ED. with the license in the 42 hour option.*
