The matches are numbered and color coded – they even tell you where the match came from. You can click on a source to see more details. Note: if the source is from another student's paper, you will not be allowed to see that source (to protect the student's privacy)

Gender Oriented Shopping

Here, we've checked out the second match. Notice it shows you where the match appears in your document. If you click on the arrow next to the %, you can see the original source – it will even take you to the web site it came from!
