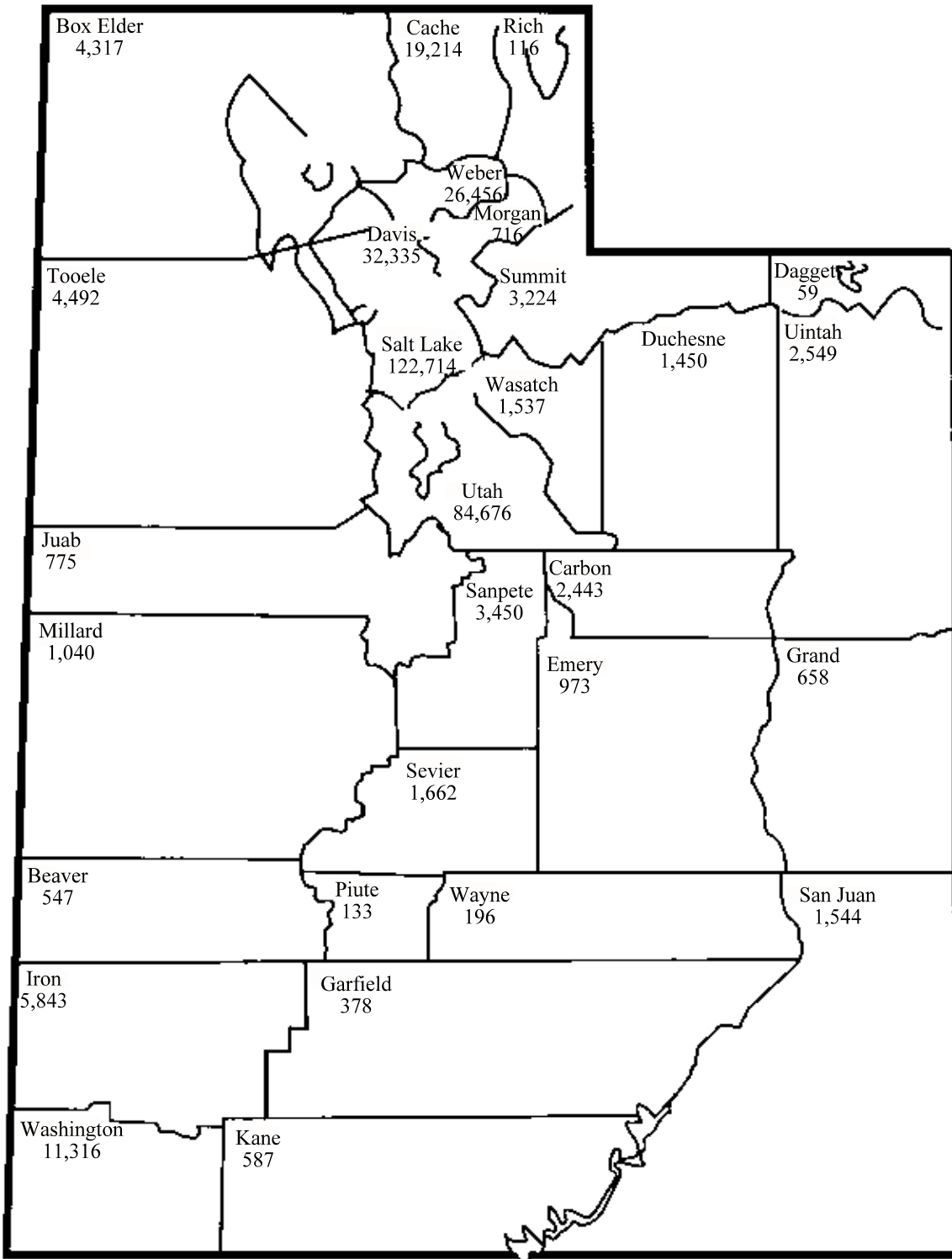

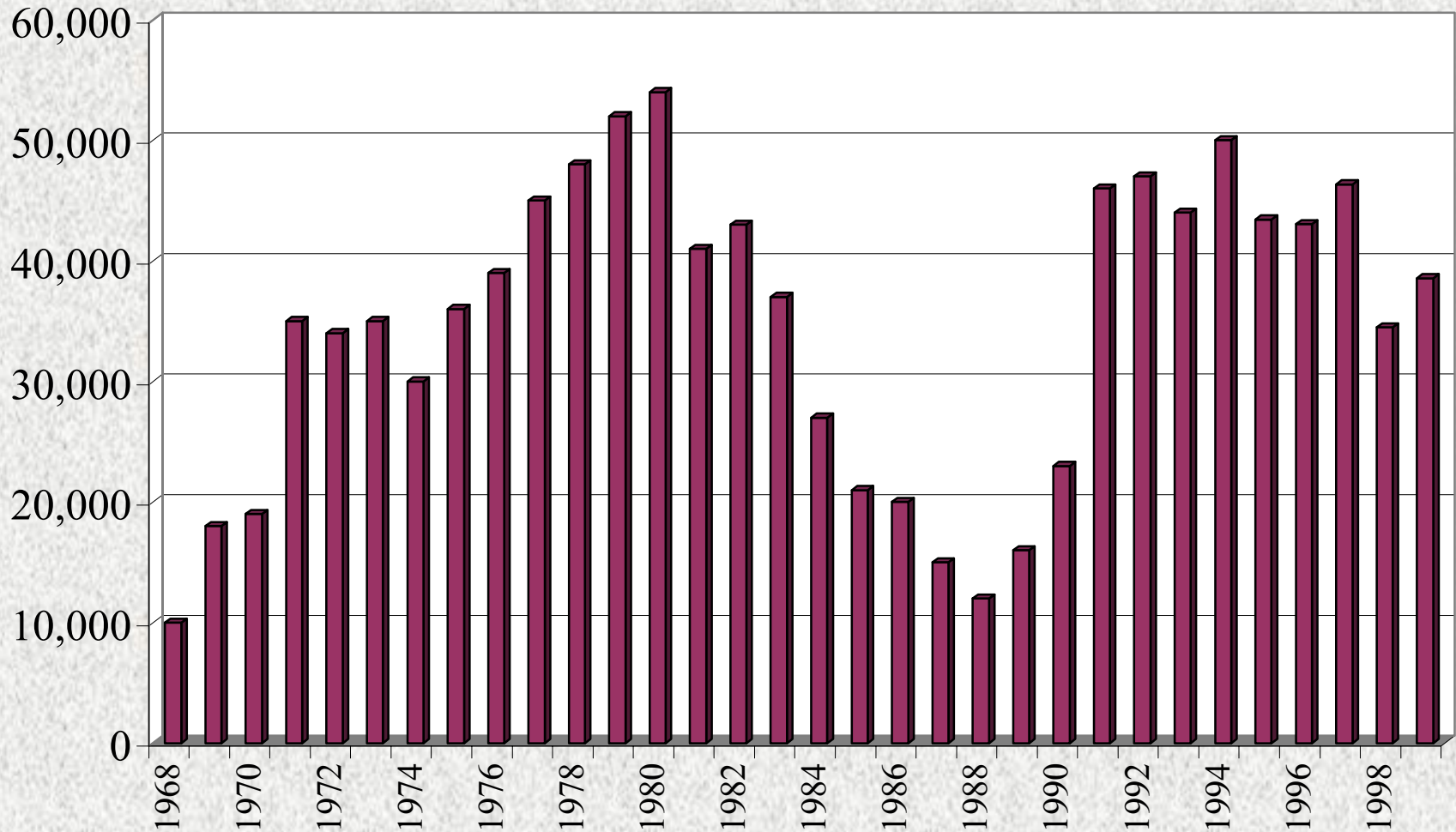

## 1999 Population of 18 to 25 Year Olds by County

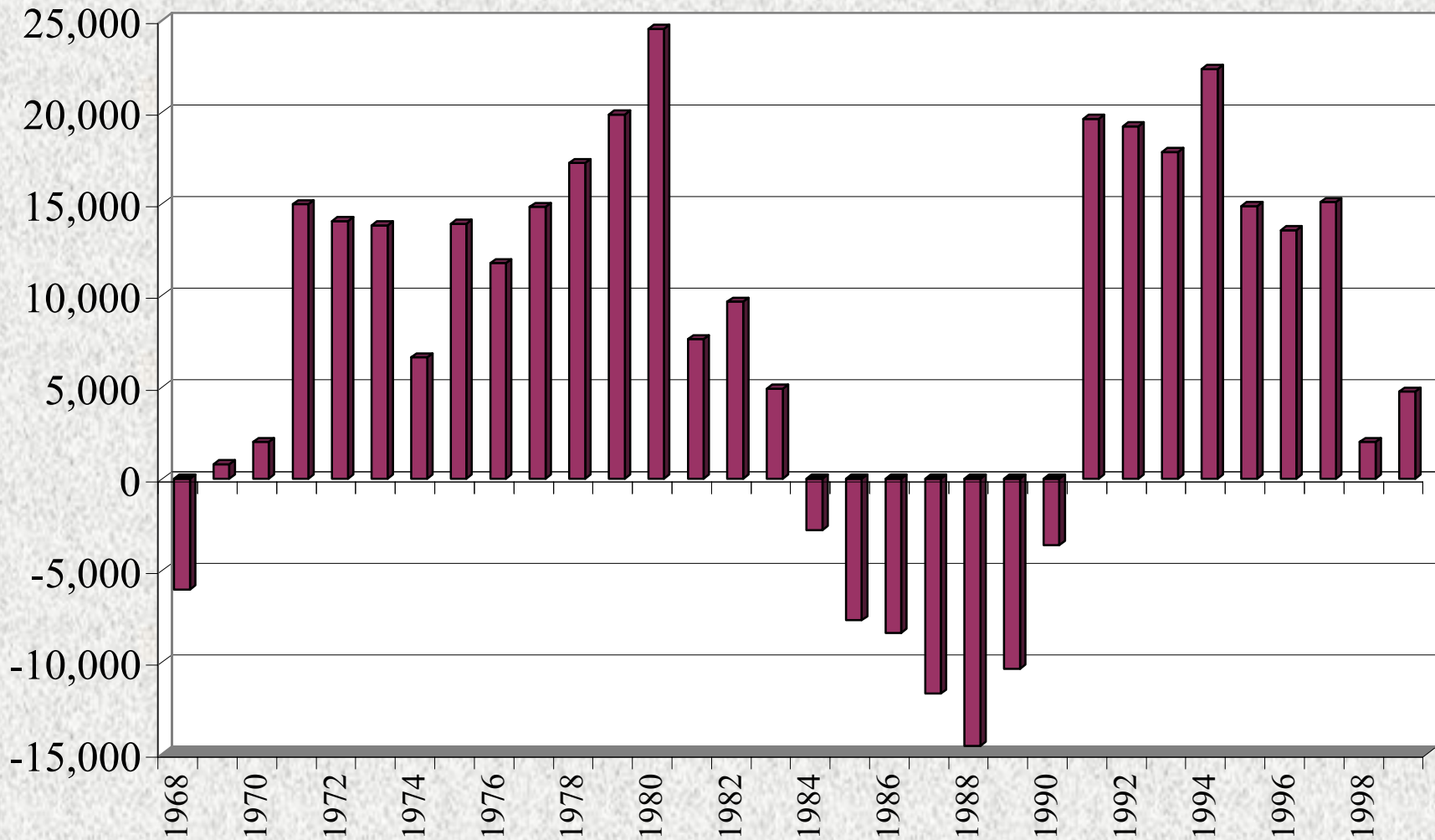

# Utah Migration Patterns 1968 to 1999



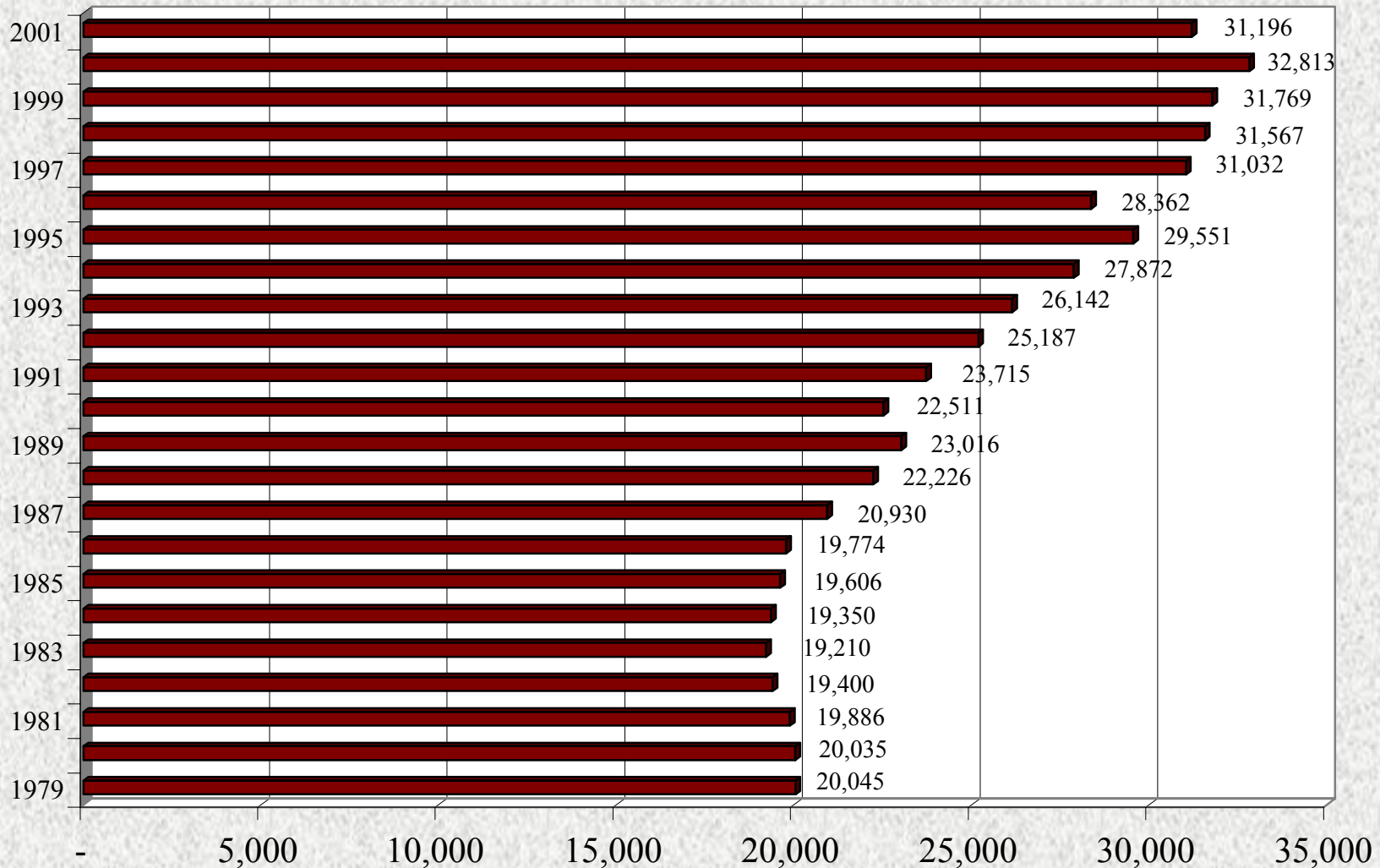

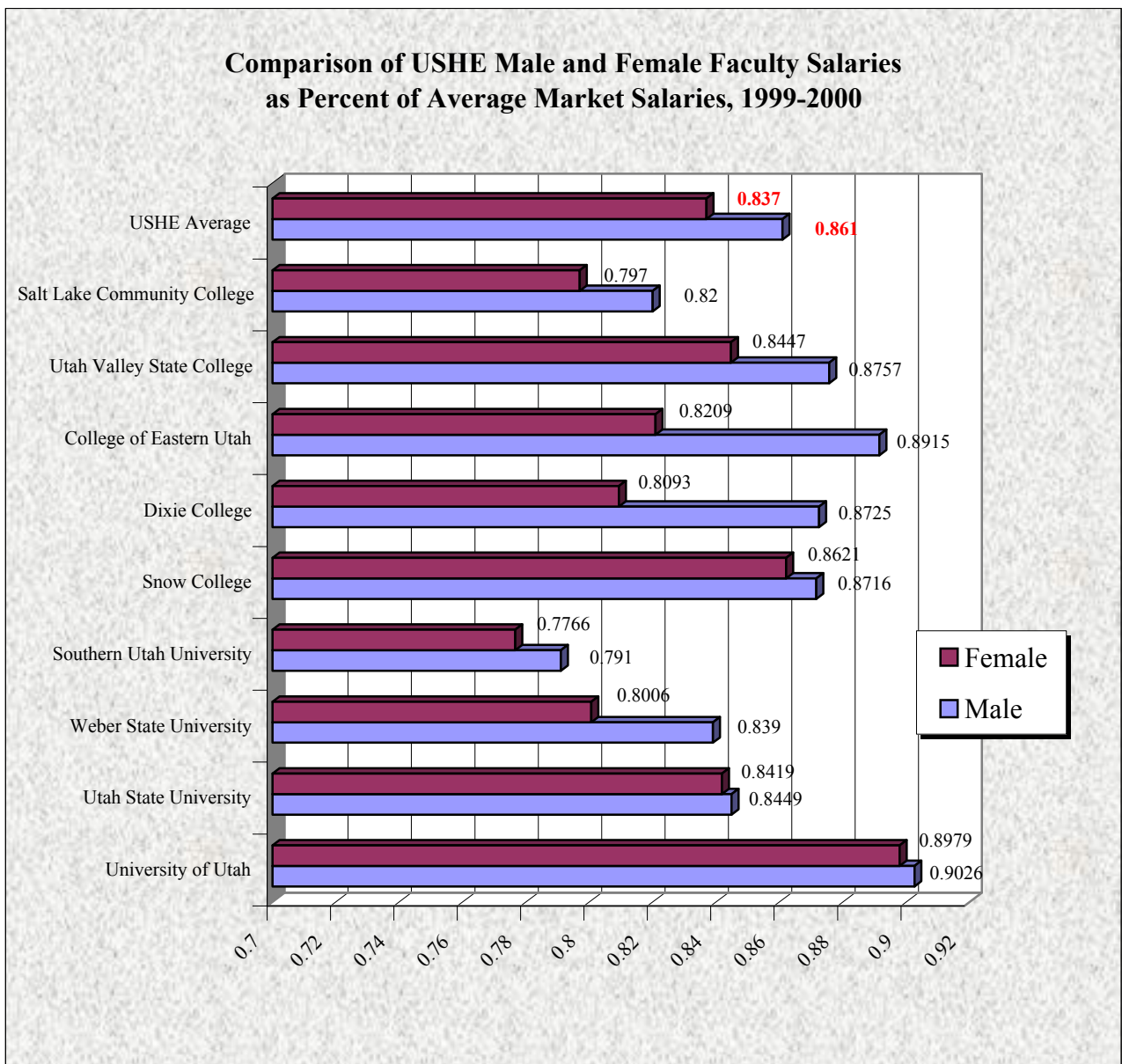
