

# Archeology Field School

## The Field Experience

The school is based in beautiful southwestern Utah in the pioneer town of Kanab (once known as Utah's Little Hollywood because so many westerns were filmed there). While in Kanab, we will stay in two apartments – complete with hot showers, air-conditioning, and internet access – that are located within walking distance of Kanab's historic downtown.

Excavations will focus on a Basketmaker III through Pueblo (aka Anasazi) period site located on the edge of town. We will also spend several days surveying for prehistoric and historic archeological sites on nearby private and public lands. Participants will gain experience in basic excavation techniques, archeological survey, and the recording of archeological data.

We follow a Mon. – Fri., 8 am -4 pm work schedule. Evenings will be dedicated to laboratory processing of artifacts, lectures on Southwestern prehistory, and plenty of free time.

Students must be able to cope with a desert environment and moderate physical activity.

The field school covers food and lodging expenses for students enrolled in the course.
