# Automated Waitlists (things to remember)

- <u>Do not override registration errors when putting students on the waitlist</u>; it will not bring up that error again when the student transfers from the waitlist to the class.
- If you put a student on a waitlist, make sure that the student knows to check his/her email frequently, as that will be the way they are notified that a seat has opened up.
- If a student does not register by the deadline noted in their email, they will automatically get dropped from the waitlist (they will not receive an email telling them that they have been dropped).
- If a seat opens up, and a student who was not notified tries to register, they will not be able to.
- After the waitlisted student receives an email, s/he can either register online for the course (as
  long as there are no errors), see an advisor, or contact the registrar's office to be registered.
- If a student tries to register online and an error comes up (time conflict, instructor's signature, etc.), the student still only has until their printed deadline to get the necessary permission and register for the class.
- An email will also be sent to <u>registrar@suu.edu</u> so that they can be printed out and scanned into BMI for record purposes.
