We are all celebrating the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the National Park Service in 2016.

Each student can enter up to three works of art in this show, which will be juried by members of the Art and Design Faculty at SUU. All work must be submitted digitally by April 1, 2016. Students should include high quality digital images of their work (300 dpi, jpg), and an artist’s statement no longer than 100 words. The students whose work(s) are selected as part of the exhibition will be notified by April 10, 2016.
