### DANCE EDUCATION MAJOR

Students wishing to teach on a secondary level must:

- 1) be approved by the dance faculty as a dance education major
- 2) choose either a teaching minor OR complete a minimum of 12 credits of enrichment courses outside of the DANC or SCED prefix. Students should consult their faculty/academic advisors as they select their enrichment courses (these courses may include BA/BS requirements)

- 3) be admitted to the Teacher Education Program.

To qualify for technique classes that are level III or above requires a placement audition. *Students must audition and be accepted as Dance Education majors and are required to consult with a faculty advisor.*

Other Requirements: Refer to College of Education department teacher license requirements.
