

## Dance Audition Info

The department is committed to your success and therefore, admits students who are qualified to complete programs of study. To qualify for major level technique classes, students must be admitted to SUU and complete a placement audition. Transfer students who have completed an Associate's Degree, must place at an intermediate technique level or above in order to complete their Bachelor Degree within a minimum two-year timeline.

The 2012 Scholarship/Class Placement Audition date is Saturday, February 11, 2012. All applicants must attend the ballet group class at 10:00 am followed by the modern dance group class. The solo/interview portion will begin at noon. Check-in and warm-ups begin at 9:00 am.

The audition dates fall on a Saturday and include a four-hour review process with the entire faculty who evaluate each potential student. The evaluation includes:

- two group technique classes (ballet and modern dance),
- a one-minute solo (choreographed by the student applicant),
- an interview with the dance faculty.

If you live outside the state or region, or are unable to attend the scheduled dates, you may contact the department for options that follow criteria established by the dance program. No student may register for major level courses without a placement audition.

Students seeking teaching licensure, in addition to the placement requirements, must 1) submit an application and be approved by the dance faculty, 2) choose a teaching minor, 3) be admitted to the Teacher Education Program.
