SUU has limited course development funds. Preference will be given to courses that have a history of strong enrollment, fill gaps in online degree programs, or serve an unmet need. Evidence to support this proposal is encouraged.

The course developer is to obtain permission to use copyrighted materials for online delivery and keep permission documentation on file in compliance with copyright law and university policy.

Online courses are to meet the same academic standard as campus courses, as determined by the academic department, and are to be structured to permit any qualified instructor to teach the course.

“E-packs” are supplemental materials provided by text book publishers and can provide useful learning tools to students. E-packs are welcome, but are not considered SUU’s intellectual property, and cannot constitute the substance of an online course. There must be sufficient course content within the Learning Management System (eLearning), to allow the course to be delivered effectively without an e-pack.
