Failure to meet those standards will require exclusion of media from the course, resulting in a breach of the Supplemental and Overload Compensation Authorization for Salaried Personnel and this contract. Accepting compensation from SCPS for the creation of this course, the undersigned hereby relinquishes to Southern Utah University all rights, permissions and ownership of this course. The Course Designer also guarantees all content and materials used in the course and has cleared the protocols of copyright, fair use, and TEACH Act requirements. The responsibility for following this protocol is solely the Course Designer's. Prior to launching or publishing, copies of IMIC approved permission/copyright release forms need to be submitted to the IMIC.

All courses electronically distributed (WebCT, EdNet/ITV, Breeze, etc.), fall within the purview of SCPS. SCPS is responsible for the distribution of the course, and the registration of the students into the classes.

This course will be offered as an out-of-state section by SCPS every- [] Fall [] Spring [] Summer. This course will be offered until it meets Distance Education's required minimum offering amount and then under the discretion of SCPS Course Administration.

The contract for compensation in the course development will be initiated upon 1) the signature of the Division Dean, 2) the delivery of this contract to the IMIC, 3) final approval by the SCPS Course Administration.
