

DEADLINE INFORMATION: All students who plan to graduate in the annual commencement ceremony each spring must turn in their graduation application by October 15th. This deadline applies to all students who are seeking associate's, bachelor's and master's degrees and who plan to complete their studies in the spring as well as the summer. Failure to turn in the paperwork by this deadline results in a late fee of \$50. This late fee is assessed even if graduates ask to be excused from the ceremony. Those students planning to graduate in December need to turn in their application by February 15th. *(If the 15th falls on a weekend we will always give the students until Monday night to turn it in. Keeping this deadline date certain allows us to make the communications permanent and advertise it a long ways in advance.)*
