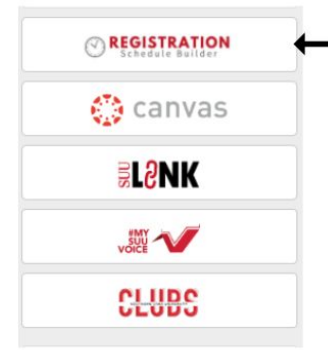


## How to search for classes

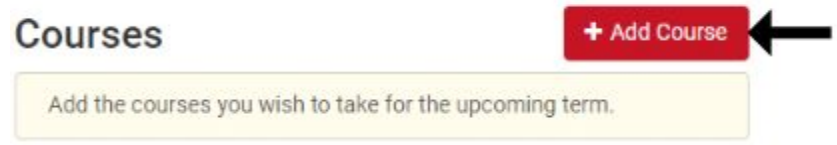
To access the schedule planning tool, visit the student portal, and click the link to launch
