

NOTICE OF SUMMER JOB OPENINGS

Job Description:

Summer positions involve living in SUU resident hall to tutor and supervise up to 60 high school students from the SUU UB Project, about 1/3 of which are Native American students. Both male and female positions are open for the six-week summer component. Tutor/supervisors will work weekdays and weekends, supervised by the project's Director and Assistant Director. All finalists will be fingerprinted for a completed background check. Taking University coursework during the summer program is discouraged.

Responsibilities:

- Serve as a positive role model for participants.
- Assist in residence hall, classroom, activity, and field trip supervision.
- Attend class, assist with classroom management, and tutor daily study sessions.
- Assess disciplinary problems and act in compliance with program guidelines.
- Work with other staff to plan and teach workshops, activities, and recreation.
- Perform other duties, attend meetings and submit paperwork as assigned.

Qualifications:

- At least 20 years of age and at least two years college completed by June 1.
- In good academic standing.
- A responsible individual who enjoys interacting with teenagers.
- Possess excellent communication, social and interpersonal skills.
- Possess strong leadership qualities and also have the ability to function as a team player.
- Able to effectively tutor in nutrition, biology, math, English, Spanish and/or German.
- Able to live in an apartment of resident housing and work extended hours.
- Also important; computer literacy, tutoring experience, possession of a valid driver's license, experience working with high school students, ability to work with a multicultural population. Experience with Native American education a plus.

Dates: May 31 through July 11, 2018 (six weeks)


Salary: \$2400 plus room and board. (Taxes withheld, salary subject to funding)
