Master of Public Administration	<p>Eliminate two (2) tracks in graduate program:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Criminal Justice 2. Non-Profit Management & Administration <p>The program has changes to the degree requirements that accompany this Degree/Program change and is separate from deleting the Criminal Justice and Non-Profit Management and Administration track.</p> <p>The first is a new elective course, PADM 6540 Higher Education Law and Policy. This course has already been approved by the governing faculty and curriculum committee and is being taught this semester, spring 2015. The course will be added to the elective options and degree requirements for the Student Services track and the General track. Adding PADM Higher Education Law and Policy will have a positive effect on the MPA emphasis in student services in higher education. Students are required to complete four electives in the track and this will expand the options to five. The additional course will broaden the elective options and</p>	Fall 2015	Approved

	<p>give all students, including those seeking a general MPA or those seeking state/local government.</p> <p>The second degree requirement change is to add PADM 6610 Public Policy Analysis to the elective options of the state and local government track. This course is currently listed as an elective option for the general track. As it stands now, the State and Local Government track has four elective options; this will expand the option to five. The rationale of adding the course to elective options is that it is critical for state and local administrators to understand public policy and how to analyze it. See attached Corresponding Catalog Changes for this degree change.</p> <p>The final degree requirement change is to delete PADM 6620 Critical Thinking and Ethics in the Public Sector from the elective options for the general track. This is due to a degree change that was made for the academic year of 2014-2015 to move the course from an elective option to a core requirement for all students. When this change was made, the program inadvertently did not remove the course from the elective options. See attached Corresponding Catalog Changes</p>
