Discussion Items

University College - Patrick Clarke - Patrick stated that SUU already has an unofficial University College Model in place. There are a collection of academic support programs housed under different administrative umbrellas on campus and academic credit is awarded in these programs. In a lot of cases, this is just a matter of formalizing what is already in place. The University College is basically a central home to a variety of different kinds of experiential education programs as opposed to having them spread across campus.

Committee members voiced their concern regarding the University College adding another layer of administration when resources are already being stretched to the limit. Instead of examining the existing programs and how efficiently our limited resources are being spent, this change will cost more money and add more fiscal strain.

Patrick thanked committee members for their input and encouraged them to let him know about any other concerns they might have.
