These changes include: 1) Changing Prefix names and course numbers from SST to THEA (approved in consent items). 2) Deletion of courses within SST that have duplicates in THEA (approved in consent items). 3) Adding THEA 3131 to the list of minor degree electives which provides for a variable content based course within the elective sequence and can be programed by the department based on available scholars or guest artists.
