Computer Science Composite, B.S.	<p>The CSIS department would like to restructure the degree with the following changes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Add a sentence to the beginning of the degree telling students that they can get through the program faster if they take specific courses as part of the GE.</li> <li>• Restructure the CSIS common core so that CS students take courses more relevant to their major. Generally, if a course is removed from the Common Core, it will be placed into either the CS Core, or the IS Core, or added as an elective. These Common Core classes are currently experiencing a bit of stress in that we might have to offer multiple sections of them. To reduce that pressure, only requiring CS, or only requiring IS students to take the courses allows a few more years before we have to create multiple sections. This reduction in the common core also allows students to have more major specific courses in their degree.</li> <li>• Restructure the CS Core. Generally, courses added would come from the Common Core, and Courses removed would go to the CS Major</li> </ul>	Fall 2018	<p>Check with Registrar regarding the statement requiring a “C” or better to count as a pre-requisite.</p> <p>Move to December meeting.</p>

	<p>Electives. We are trying to follow the Association for Computing Machinery (ACM) guidelines in what material should be in the core, and these changes put us more in line with those guidelines.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Add a section to the degree called CS Electives that would more prominently display Undergraduate Research and Internships. This section would also suggest that students couldn't take more than 3 credits of internship credit.</li> <li>• <i>Add in a sentence telling students that they need a C (2.0) or better for classes to count as a pre-req.</i></li> <li>• Add in a sentence relating to the National Exit Exam. We have found students don't read about it being required in our other documentation and would like the sentence on the actual degree.</li> <li>• With the Edge program officially? having 3 credits instead of 1-3 credits, we have adjusted the Totals Credits to reflect that change.</li> </ul>
