3. Discussion:

- At present, almost all the courses required for the Special Education minor still require admission to the College of Education’s Teacher Education program to enroll. This does not fit well with the provided program rationale, which states that the intention behind the minor is to open the program up to non-Education students. The courses selected also appear to still carry a heavy focus on teacher preparation and may not benefit non-Education majors going into other professions.
- One historical reason why the Special Education minor is being proposed is to help with student advising. Some UCC members feel that is not an appropriate reason to create a new minor.

- UUCC recommends sending the SPED minor back to the college to either (1) change the minor courses to meet a broader student interest or (2) adjust the rationale to make clear that this program is still intended only for Education students.

08 Discussion Items

- Courses with “ESL majors may not enroll” registration restrictions (see list in Drive)
 - There are currently 301 courses in Banner and the Catalog that have a restriction on enrolling students in the Intensive English Program. The Associate Provost’s Office does not know the history or rationale why these restrictions were placed on this set of courses.
 - Several UUCC members questioned why the courses have this restriction, and if a potential solution would be to indicate a minimum TOEFL score if English language proficiency was the main concern.
 - UUCC recommended discussing this list with Robb McCollum to determine how many students are impacted by these restrictions and if he has any insight into the intention behind the restriction. The Associate Provost’s Office will contact Robb and work with him.
 - Brian Swanson moved to recommend the removal of all ESL major restrictions. Jeb Branin seconded, with unanimous approval. James Sage will bring this list forward to the Deans’ Council for their thoughts and recommendations.

- Residency credits for certificates
 - At present, there is no language in the General Catalog that states how many credits a student must complete at SUU in order to earn a certificate, unlike such residency requirements for associate degrees, bachelor degrees, and master degrees. The Associate Provost's Office would like to propose some language for addition in the catalog to address this lack.
 - UUCC recommends requiring 50% of the certificate coursework to be completed at SUU.
 - The Associate Provost's Office will write up the catalog language and present it at the January UUCC meeting for discussion and approval.
 - There was a question on if minors also had a residency requirement, and if they don't, do we want to develop one? The main difference between a certificate and a minor is that a certificate can be awarded/posted on the student's transcript at any time, while a minor can only be awarded with a bachelor's degree at the end of study. There was no definitive decision on whether or not to develop minor residency minimums.
- Plan review of Policies 6.8, 6.8.1, and 6.8.2
 - It's a good idea to periodically review policies and it's time to look over the curriculum policies, especially with the upcoming implementation of Curriculog. For example, one thing that should likely be removed is the list of specific forms that curriculum must use, as that does not allow for flexibility or updates.
 - Jeb Branin and Caitlin Kime have volunteered to be on an ad-hoc task force to review the policies, along with Katya Konkle.
 - Policy revision is not on the same timeline as catalog/curriculum updates. The revised policies can be submitted as late as the final UUCC meeting in April 2019.
