 - PVA education degrees are trying to work to get credit totals down and looking to embed specific courses instead of relying on COEHD courses.

- Discussion:
 - Some program changes are result of working through accreditation site evaluation and self-study. Accreditors had concerns with title “Ceramics/Sculpture” and that we don’t offer enough sculpture work/courses. Also eliminated repeatability in beginning and intermediate ceramics courses.
 - ARTH 3750 is no longer required in foundation but still required overall.
 - Senior Portfolio course is currently only taught in fall. They are restructuring it so that all students will have fall & spring sections to manage a year-long project, which will result in more interaction with students and increased coverage of professional practices.
 - Photography has some curriculum updates that change the way students progress through program; also pulled all non-photo courses and replaced them with photo courses in the minor.
 - Secondary Art Ed major and minor are trying to reduce credit loads so students are closer to around 120 credits instead of higher; also added three “tracks” so it’s not strictly focused on K-12 education.

 - Discussion:
 - Q: What is the purpose of STCH courses? Thought SUU had articulated everything that could be articulated. (A: [These courses are better than an ELEC undifferentiated block and students can still earn credits for STECH work without direct equivalency.](#)) Is NWCCU okay with this? (A: [There are only three programs still to come through that will use these STCH credits.](#)) Will STECH have new courses that we have to evaluate on a case-by-case basis? (A: [Likely not, unless STECH develops an entirely new certificate program.](#))
 - Add “1776” course number to SUU 1776 proposal form as friendly amendment. UCC also recommended to remove the “and Polity” from the title to reduce confusion (people may think it’s a misspelling of “policy,” USU’s similar course is just “American Institutions,” etc.), and recommendation was accepted as friendly amendment. General Education Committee has already given its approval for the GE American Institutions requirement pending its approval as a course.
 - This course would be a great place for someone from COEHD to fit into one of the combined course offerings, as education touches on all aspects of life.
 - Q: Saw margin comment asking if 0700-courses could be undergraduate level. Doesn’t anything below 1000 not count as undergraduate? (A: [That comment was added because we’ve had other 0700-level courses approved as continuing education courses so there was some confusion, but we do already actually have a UNIV 0700 course. These courses serve a unique role because when students go abroad, they don’t always know exactly how many credits they will](#)

take. Courses are acting as a placeholder for those students. Also, for short-term study abroad, Office of Learning Abroad is requiring more touchpoints for students before they leave in order to “certify” a student as ready to go abroad and would like to deliver it in some semblance of a course format. Will also provide a place to put the bill for study abroad in a differentiated spot to help avoid confusion/issues.) Will they show on transcripts or are they temporary? (A: If they are replaced by returning credits the courses would go away, but if not, they will be permanent.)

- Q: On the discussion board it was pointed out that these courses might not be eligible for financial aid. Is UNIV 0710 intended to be used with our partners, whom students can use their SUU financial aid with, and if so, will they actually be able to use it with this course on their record? (A: Office of Learning Abroad has confirmed with Financial Aid that students will be able to use their aid. OLA has been doing this with one of their programs already and it has been working well. If there is a problem, they simply don’t need to offer the courses.)
- New “INDS” prefix is follow-up from previous meeting to find a prefix that doesn’t include reference to degree/level of courses.

- Discussion:
 - Q: Part of the program modification is changing how the diploma reads for the degree emphases/tracks. Does anything need to be changed/updated in the catalog entry to reflect this? (A: No. This change is intended to reflect what other schools do, such as Dixie State, to be more descriptive about what the students have studied. Also, it will be mostly reflected on transcript, not the actual diploma. Diploma should now read “Bachelor of Interdisciplinary Studies.”)
 - Changes to the BIS is based on students being confused about the tracks and what credits were needed. SIEL accepts the suggestion to change the tracks in Option 2 to be more readily divided by 3-credit courses. Total credits were also adjusted because the intro course (BIS 2000) was changed to 3 credits.
 - Q: Will only one prefix be allowed in each grouping (e.g., one is all HRHM and one is all ART), or could one grouping be made with similar subjects like ART & ARTH? (A: Disciplines/prefixes should be the same in each grouping, but exceptions could be made. Students who need a lot more flexibility would be directed to General Studies instead. This might be tricky with education courses, with the amount of different prefixes they have for education courses— EDUC, ELED, SPED, EDRG, etc.) Do departments still have sign off on tracks? (A: No, it’s all done within IES. In this case, it’s a matter of advising and this can be trained.)

- Discussion:
 - Updating every upper-division course in BUS in support of moving away from “Advanced Standing” (which students don’t understand) and replacing with a formalized process for admission to the school. Main motivation is to help make connections with students sooner and help with career planning. There will be more work on the advisors at first but will save them work later when they will not have to fix as many problems. Also cleaning up redundancies and minor errors in prerequisites.
 - Students will be enrolled/declared as “regular” business majors (in order to remain eligible for financial aid) and then be admitted into a specific track of upper-division study. It will be similar to what is already done with Elementary Education and BFA Art majors.
 - For internship courses, there are only specific things we can do with enrollment restrictions (i.e., specific majors, class levels, etc.). We have traditionally placed “Instructor permission” in the prerequisites. BUS is fine with changes.
 - Q: HRHM 4750 isn’t listed in the previously approved Event Planning emphasis and minor. Is it supposed to take the place of HRHM 4120 Event Planning and Management? (A: [Will find answer after the meeting.](#))

- COEHD has some new faculty who have a passion for education policy and critical issues in education. Teacher Education is proposing new courses as pure electives and not requiring them in any programs at this point. Anyone with a doctorate in education can teach them and is a high-interest area among COEHD faculty.
 - Q: Does UCC not need to consider additional resources when reviewing curriculum? (A: [Should be the purview of the department chairs and deans. UCC focus is the coherence of the curriculum.](#)) Why are there items on the curriculum forms about resources? (A: [It's more about transparency, but knowing that the resource question was raised is important. After we approve the next step is the Provost, so resources is also considered at that level.](#))
 - Special Education minor is a resubmit from November 2018. It seems much more concise now. They removed enrollment restrictions to the SPED courses as well. COEHD would like to remind the UCC that this minor will be valuable to any major (business, computer science, social sciences, etc.). Number of people with autism has grown over the past couple of decades and are currently in or will soon be in the workforce. Background in this area will become a necessity for people to have to work effectively and legally.
 - Q: Could the name be rethought in the future? “Special Education” seems to be exclusively for Education majors. If it truly is applicable to a broad range, the name may be giving the wrong impression. (A: [Utah is way behind the curve on this. Many other institutions in the U.S. have moved from “special education” to “exceptionalities.”](#))

 - Three new THEA courses (THEA 1411, THEA 2411, and THEA 3411) were approved at PVA college curriculum level but did not make their way to UUCC for approval. Brian Swanson uploaded them to the PVA college curriculum Google folder and Katya Konkle opened them for the UUCC to view on the TV. Motion to approve includes these three courses.
 - New courses are vocal instruction. Currently all vocal instruction is done through the Music Dept. but Theatre and Dance now has a musical theatre voice specialist faculty member and can teach musical theatre-specific courses (different focus and methodology than classic music courses). THEA 1411 will be elective for Classical Acting Emphasis and THEA 2411 & 3411 will be required for Musical Theatre Emphasis.
 - Q: How dependent on a specific faculty member are these courses? (A: Theatre has a dedicated line for this, so if the current faculty member leaves, they should be able to replace.)
 - THEA 4950 number was chosen because it mimics the Dance Education courses, but there is no objection to having the course be THEA 4905 instead. Dance may change their course number in the future to align.
 - Q: Title of COMM 4040 came up in HSS college curriculum with concern from some faculty about the word “psychology.” Will there be any concerns with the marketing faculty about the word “advertising”? (A: No, there shouldn’t be.)
 - PSY 4515 is to give students choice between working with animals and working with humans. Some students are very opposed to working in the animal lab so this course will allow those students an option.

- Q: Is it unusual for an administrator to be in charge of curriculum instead of a faculty member? (A: [We actually receive curriculum items mostly from associate deans now.](#))
- We are still working to move forward with Curriculog starting next year’s curriculum cycle.
