

# FACULTY/STAFF INCENTIVE TO STUDY ABROAD

The Office of Learning Abroad is piloting a program to reward faculty and staff who encourage students to study abroad by awarding them university-related international travel or a study abroad scholarship in their names.



When a student applies for study abroad that offers at least 3 course credits, he or she is asked to list one or two faculty or staff who encouraged him or her to participate. After the student has completed a study abroad program, the faculty or staff member(s) will receive a point (or half-point, if two are listed) towards a trip of their own. Faculty and staff members can also choose to have their points converted to a study abroad scholarship.

## HOW TO EARN POINTS

Faculty and staff who, by July 1st, 2018, have accumulated:

**1-4 points:** acknowledgement on the OLA website

**5-9 points:** a \$500 stipend for the faculty/staff member to travel on behalf of the OLA (perhaps to conduct research for a future study abroad program or to add a short visit to an overseas trip paid for with other funds, etc.)

**10-14 points:** an \$1,100 stipend to travel on behalf of the OLA

**15+ points:** a 5-day, all-expenses-paid trip to visit one of SUU's partner universities (or an \$1,800 stipend to travel on other OLA-related business)
