

Academic Plan: Bachelor of Fine Arts Art Education with Secondary Teaching Licensure

The following is a sample outline for completion of this bachelor's degree AND state-required courses for becoming a licensed teacher (completion of licensing often requires semester(s) beyond four years). Each student's reality will vary slightly, as this plan does not include transfer work, Advanced Placement (AP), or concurrent enrollment credits.
