



123rd ANNUAL COMMENCEMENT

Southern Utah University honored the class of 2022 with its annual commencement ceremony. After two years of modified ceremonies due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, the commencement exercises for the university returned to normal with one day packed with celebration. The 123rd graduating class was addressed by former U.S. Secretary of State, Condoleezza Rice who spoke of continuing global conflict and encouraged students to be activie citizens drawing upon their SUU education to make the world better. For the first time in SUU history, all three of the commencement speakers were women as Interim-President, Mindy Benson conducted the ceremony.


