romanickjocelyn.youcanbook.me. Fall 2020 semester balance is due September 9th in full, or you need to be signed up for a payment plan.

Keep your eye out for details from your federal student loan servicer about continued Student Loan Payment Relief, which "..provide(s) such deferments to borrowers as necessary to continue the temporary cessation of payments and the waiver of all interest on student loans held by the Department of Education until December 31, 2020. All persons who wish to continue making student loan payments shall be allowed to do so, notwithstanding the deferments.." This also applies to federal loans taken out for this Fall 2020 semester.
