

Program Costs

The Southern Utah University Athletic Training Program strives to keep associated costs to a minimum to lessen the financial responsibility of the student. In addition to tuition and fees of the university, additional fees are the responsibility of the student. The following is a list of items that are the responsibility of the athletic training student: Acquiring appropriate immunizations (MMR, Hepatitis B series, Tdap, Td, Varicella); Tuberculosis test; passing of a drug test (\$30); completing a background check (\$70); travel to and from clinical education sites; Emergency Cardiac Care certification; any items of clothing considered “professional dress” not provided by the University. The cost of immunizations, TB test, background check, drug test, etc. will vary based on the location on services rendered. The student will also incur additional expenses including books, supplies, equipment and costs associated with travel to professional conferences and symposia.
