PROGRAM OVERVIEW

SUU's International Early College provides you with the opportunity to earn your associate's degree and high school diploma in two years. You will be eligible to enroll in this unique program after completing the 10th or 11th year of high school. You can enroll full time in university coursework while fulfilling the high school diploma requirements at the same time.

ENGLISH REQUIREMENTS: TOEFL IBT 71 or IELTS 6.0

If you do not meet the English proficiency minimums, you may begin in our Intensive English Program (IEP) or qualify for the Dual Enrollment Program. Admission to early college is guaranteed upon successful completion of our IEP program.

HOUSING

Our Homestay Housing is specially designed for you in our International Early College Program. Here you will live with a local family and share their culture in a place that feels like home and with people that care about your success.

INTERNATIONAL EARLY COLLEGE ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

1. Application - Pay required \$60 Application Fee.
Application Deadlines: **Fall Semester - July 15th**
Spring Semester - November 15th
2. English Proficiency - Provide proof of English proficiency via TOEFL IBT 71 or IELTS 6.0 or successful completion of our IEP program.
3. Transcripts - Submit high school transcript(s) demonstrating a 2.0 minimum grade point average (GPA) on a U.S. 4.0 GPA scale.
4. Passport - Provide a Copy of Photo Page of your Passport.
5. Finances - International students are required to demonstrate that funds are available for the first year of study via an official document from a banking institution.
