## ONLINE

Early College Online (ECO) allows students to take entry-level university courses while still in high school. Credits earned through ECO count towards a GE Certificate, an Associate's Degree, or a Bachelor's Degree.

#### Flexible Schedule

Courses are online and asynchronous. You can do them anywhere and at your own pace. There are deadlines to help with pacing.

## **Save Money**

These courses are provided at a reduced rate of just \$75 per credit. That means a 3-credit course, will cost \$225 USD plus any additional textbooks and/or course fees. This can help save a lot of money.

#### **Accelerated Education**

By taking university classes while still in high school, you can potentially shorten the time needed to complete a degree.

The general education courses we provide help you explore a variety of subjects and help you develop a well-rounded understanding of the world beyond a specific major.
