Here, learning goes far beyond the classroom — students explore breathtaking landscapes, gain hands-on experience in the outdoors, and prepare for careers shaped by discovery, leadership, and the natural world.



## **Zion National Park** *Utah's first national park*

Established in 1919 as Utah's first and most celebrated national park, Zion truly lives up to its name — a place of heaven on earth. Towering cliffs of cream, pink, and red rise above lush canyon floors, transforming with each season from vibrant greens to snow-dusted whites. Every trail offers a view that takes your breath away. Join a guided Ecology hike through the Zion Canyon, where the story of ancient seas and shifting stone unfolds beneath your feet.





## **Bryce Canyon National Park** *Best 3 miles hike in the world*

Carved by wind, water, and time, **Bryce Canyon** is a masterpiece of color and form — a vast natural amphitheater glowing in red, gold, and rose. Home to the world's largest collection of hoodoos, its slender spires rise like a cathedral of stone. From the rim, the horizon stretches endlessly; within the canyon, each step reveals quiet magic. Whether gazing from above or wandering below, Bryce Canyon leaves every visitor breathless — a place where the Earth seems to dream in stone.



## Cedar Break National Monument

Perched high in the mountains above Cedar City, **Cedar Breaks** is a hidden crown of the Colorado Plateau — a vast amphitheater glowing with the colors of fire and sunset. Often called a miniature Bryce Canyon, its painted cliffs reveal millions of years of uplift and erosion. Within its great circle lie spires, arches, and pinnacles in shades of crimson, gold, and violet. Ancient bristlecone pines cling to the rim, guardians of centuries past, while summer meadows burst into a brilliant sea of wildflowers. Encircled by the pines and aspens of the Dixie National Forest, Cedar Breaks is a place where alpine air meets desert stone — serene, colorful, and endlessly alive.





## Colorado River Horseshoe Bend/ Antelope Canyon *Once-in-a-lifetime adventure*

Discover two of the American Southwest's most breathtaking natural wonders in one unforgettable adventure. **Horseshoe Bend**, a sweeping curve of the Colorado River carved deep into red sandstone, captures the imagination of every traveler who stands upon its edge. From the overlook, the emerald river bends gracefully below, reflecting the ever-changing desert sky. Venture into the **Antelope Canyon**, one of the most photographed slot canyons in the world. Follow a local Navajo guide through narrow sandstone corridors sculpted by wind and water over thousands of years. Watch as sunlight filters down through the narrow openings, creating a magical display of shifting colors and shapes.



## Frontier Homestead State Park *Pioneer living experience*

Step back in time and learn about the history and development of Iron County at the Frontier Homestead State Park Museum. Museum displays include horse-drawn vehicles used from 1850 to 1920, a collection of pioneer artifacts, and the only known remaining artifact from the original iron foundry – the town bell. In addition to the permanent collections, changing special exhibits highlight artists from the local region, as well as rarely seen artifacts from the museum's collections. Other items of interest include several historic cabins, a large collection of horse-drawn farm equipment, and Cedar City's oldest remaining brick home, the Hunter House.
