## International Affairs at SUU

With students as its highest priority, the Southern Utah University Office of International Affairs fosters globally engaged communities by supporting the exchange of values, cultures, and ideas in an effort to advance a more just, empathic, and prosperous world. The Division is comprised of several departments, staff, and services which include:

### International Recruitment

Recruits globally diverse and talented students from around the world.

### American Language & Culture Center (ALCC)

Provides language and culture support to students and community members for whom English is a second language.

### International Student and Scholar Services

Facilitates a wide array of support services designed to promote the academic and social success of international students and scholars.

### Learning Abroad

Coordinates SUU's study abroad and exchange programs as well as students' Global EDGE projects.

### Short Term Programs and Homestay

Provides global connections that allow students to experience the U.S. in a more immersive, personal way.

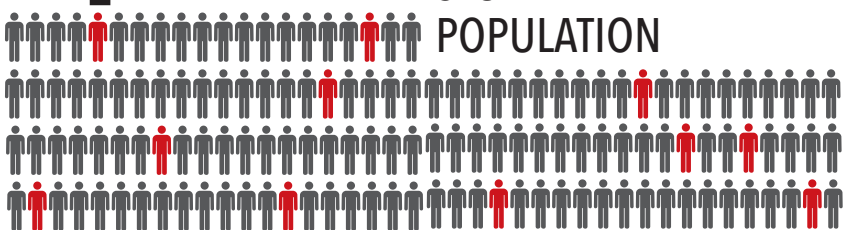
### Confucius Institute

Promotes Chinese language and culture on campus and in the region.

## Did You Know...

- **International Recruitment** International Recruitment has a team of recruiters with strategic focus on diversifying our international student population on campus.
- The **ALCC** includes an Intensive English Program, Dual Enrollment Program, and workshop classes. The ALCC also offers a Community ESL Program that is supported by Zions Bank. All of the ALCC programs include experiential learning and language & content integration.
- **International Student and Scholar Services** has hosted or will host over 90 events, services, and excursions in the 2017-2018 school year designed for international students to connect and engage with domestic and other international students.
- **Learning Abroad** helped over 300 T-birds engage in significant learning experiences abroad in 2016-17.
- In partnership with Iron County School District and SUU's **Confucius Institute**, a Chinese dual immersion program began at Fiddlers Elementary Fall 2017.

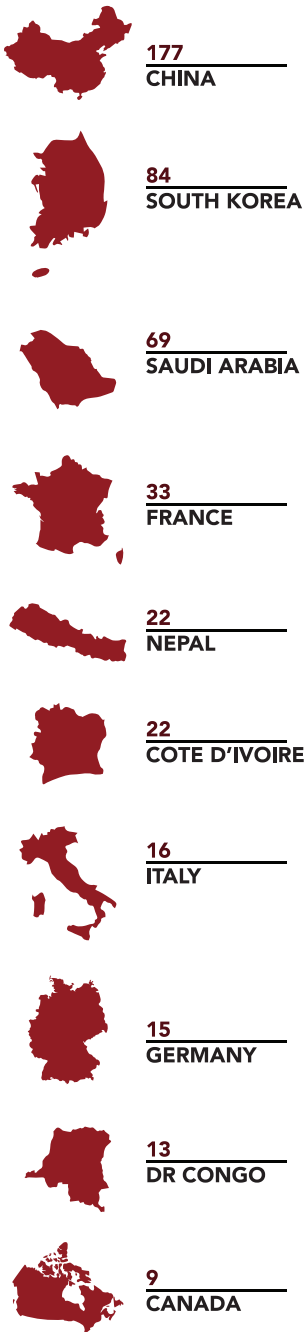
**6 percent** INTERNATIONAL STUDENT POPULATION

of SUU's enrollment comprised of international students

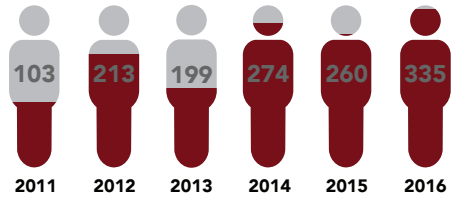

of SUU students participating in study abroad

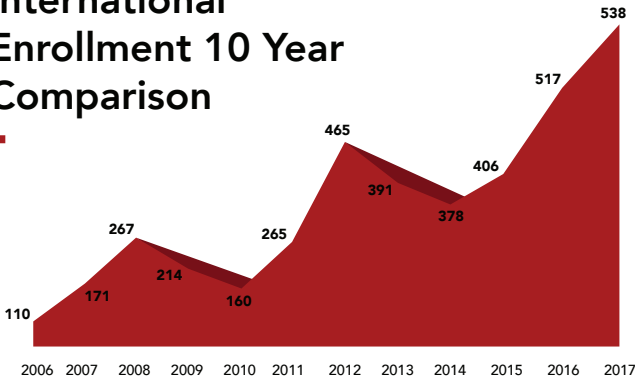

of faculty and staff with meaningful global experiences in their background

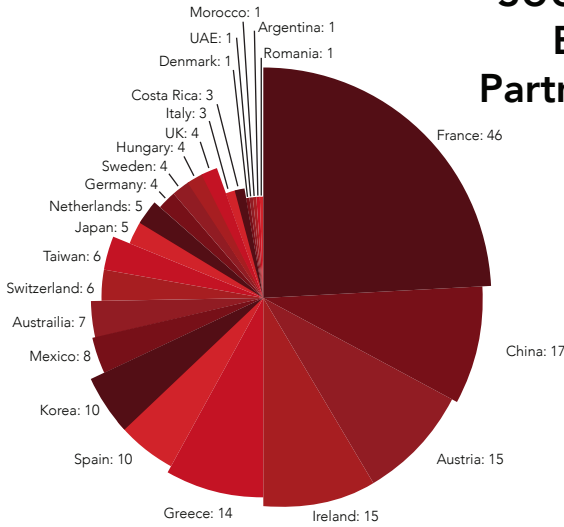
## SUU Students Studying Abroad



## International Enrollment 10 Year Comparison

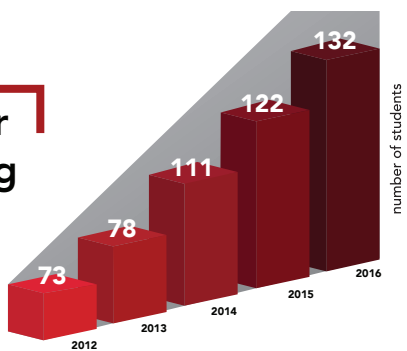


## SUU Students on Exchange at a Partner University
