This form is to be completed by students who are requesting that dependents (Spouse, Daughter, and/or Son) be added to their immigration record.

**Please note:** adding dependents requires proof of funds to cover \$6,000 for a spouse and \$3,000 per child single and under 21 years old.

**Instructions:**

1. Submit a new Financial Statement Form showing ability to cover costs of dependents.
  - a. Copies of bank statements
  - b. Copies of letters from a sponsoring institution
2. Submit copies of passports for all listed dependents
3. Submit copies of marriage licenses for spouses
4. Submit copies of birth certificates for children

Dependents are required to complete the following:

1. Provide immunization records (MMR)
2. Proof of negative Tuberculosis (TB) test results
3. Proof of insurance that meets minimums required by SUU

**Restrictions for an F-2 Visa**

- F-2 spouses may not engage in full-time study however, they can complete their desired program of study.
- F-2 children may only study full-time if they will be engaged in the k-12 education levels

**Can an F-2 visa holder work while in the United States?**

- F-2 holders are not eligible for any type of employment.

**Can an F-2 dependent visa be changed to an F-1 student visa?**

- Yes, as long as the change is to pursue a full-time course of study with the intent of completing a specific program of study.

**How does an F-2 dependent visa holder maintain their status?**

- An F-2 dependent's immigration status is tied to that of the F-1 visa holder; if the F-1 student visa holder is in status, then so is the F-2 dependent.

**Can an F-2 dependent stay in the United States while the primary F-1 student visa holder leaves the country for an extended vacation term?**

- No, F-2 visa holders must accompany the primary F-1 visa holder while they are out of the United States.

**Can a child attend elementary school while in the United States?**

- Yes, in order to be eligible, you will need to ensure that your child has received the required vaccinations.

**How can a dependent obtain a T-number if they want to take classes at SUU?**

- In order to receive a T-number, the dependent will need to submit an admission application and pay the \$55.00 application fee.

**Can an F-2 dependent switch to an F-1 visa?**

- Yes, once this has been done the dependent will need to be removed from the primary F-1 visa holder's SEVIS record.

**What happens if dependents are not insured or receive the required immunization and TB test?**

- An administrative hold will be placed on the principal F-1 visa holder's account preventing class registration.
