

Health Care can be very expensive in the United States. To protect students from these high costs, international students are required to hold insurance during their time as an SUU student. This form is to be completed by the student to show proof of their insurance coverage. You will also need to bring a copy of your policy to International Student & Scholar Services. You are required to provide ISSS with updated insurance information each semester.

Your policy must meet or exceed these minimums required by Southern Utah University:

- Medical Benefits \$100,000 (\$200,00 is preferred but not required)
- Max Deductible \$500
- Medical Evacuation \$50,000
- Repatriation \$25,000

*Failure to hold adequate insurance coverage will result in a hold on your account. This hold may be released by obtaining proper insurance.
