## Dewey Decimal Classification System Basics

Before Melvil Dewey standardized things in 1876, different libraries organized their materials in very different ways. Even within one library there would be different systems, sometimes even just by just adding new books to the end of the collection or sticking them on a shelf where they fit.

Books were often just assigned a number according to the order in which they were acquired or where they were on the shelf. Then Dewey came up with a system where a number corresponded to a subject area. This allows a user to look in one area for all the books on a particular topic.

Below is a guide to the sections of the Dewey Decimal Classification System (DDS), divided by hundreds and tens.
