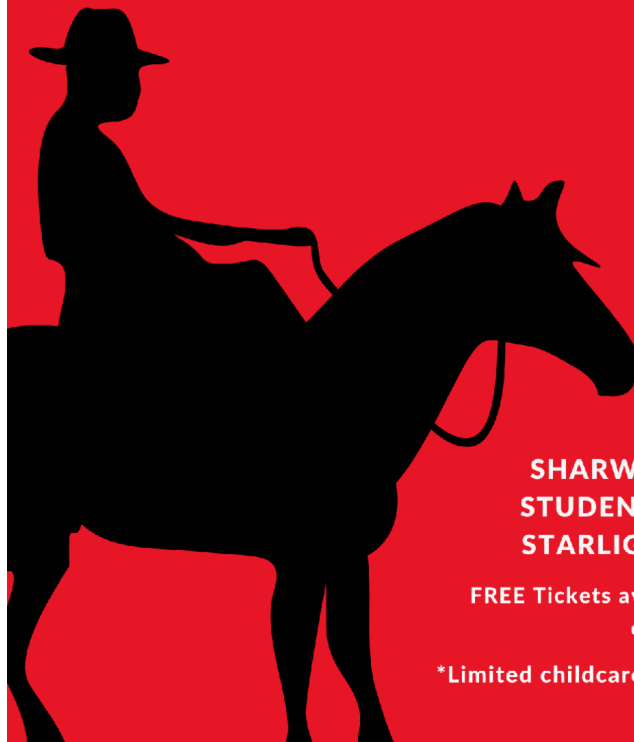

Community Connection Fair

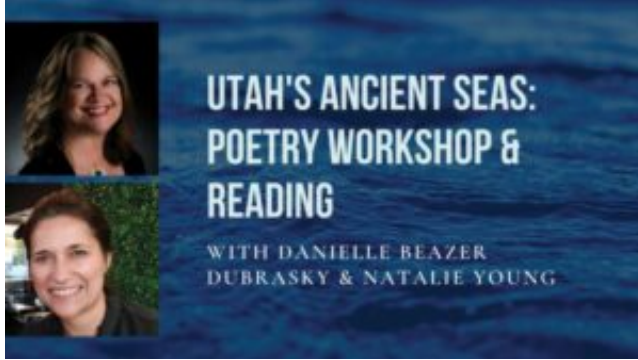
