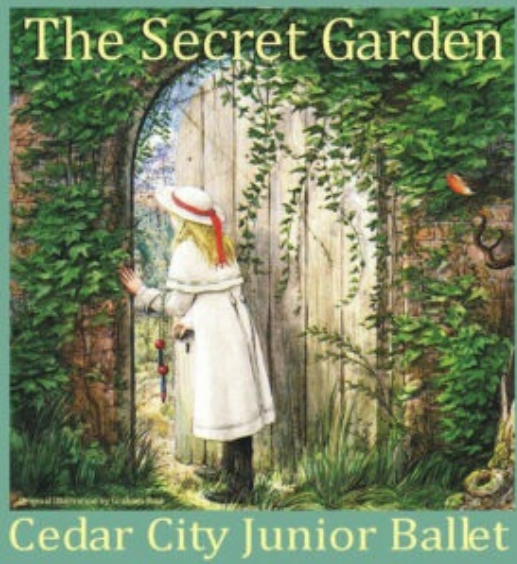

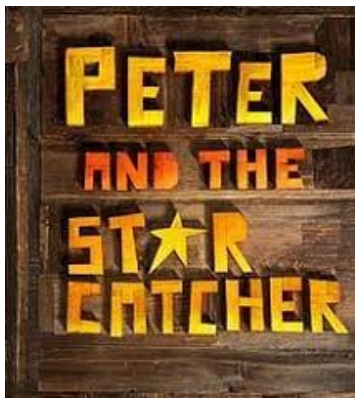
Junior Ballet: The Secret Garden
