SUBJECT: CREDIT HOUR LOADS

PURPOSE: Provide parameters on the maximum amount of credit a student can earn at SUU each semester.

POLICY:

1. The normal credit hour load for full-time undergraduate students who are not on academic probation is 12-18 credit hours each semester. Students with an SUU grade point average of 3.5 or higher may enroll in up to three (3) additional credit hours during fall and spring semesters. Undergraduate students may take up to 16 credit hours during the summer no more than eight (8) credit hours are taken per five-week summer block. No more than four credit hours may be taken during Maymester.
2. Graduate students in good standing may enroll in up to 15 credit hours during each semester and up to 12 credit hours during the summer session (including Maymester). Graduate students on probation are limited to nine (9) credit hours per term including summer and are prohibited from taking Maymester courses.
