SUU's DEPARTMENT OF MUSIC PRESENTS
CLARINETIST PANCE ZAEV IN RECITAL
OCTOBER 16, 2014

Southern Utah University, Cedar City, Utah: Whether they are compositions for classical or contemporary clarinet, **Pance Zaev** is a master of all. This gifted artist on the clarinet will perform in a free recital presented by **Southern Utah University's Department of Music**. Featuring works by Bernstein and Poulenc, the performance begins at **7:30pm** on **Thursday, October 16th** in **Thorley Recital Hall** within SUU's Music Building. The concert is **open to the public**.

For his recital, Pance Zaev will perform Dimitrije Buzarovski's (b. 1952) *20 Variations on a Macedonian Folk Song for Solo Clarinet*. He will be accompanied by **Christian Bohnenstengel**, SUU Assistant Professor of Piano, for Leonard Bernstein's (1918-1990) *Sonata for Clarinet and Piano* and Francis Poulenc's (1899-1963) *Sonata for Clarinet and Piano*. The evening will conclude with Zaev and Bohnenstengel performing a medley of jazz standards, and they will be accompanied by **Thomas Herb** on saxophone, **Jacob Lee** on bass and **Lydia Bradshaw** on drums.

A native of Strumica, which is the largest city in the eastern part of the Republic of Macedonia, clarinetist **Pance Zaev** currently serves on the faculty of Nebraska Wesleyan University where he teaches clarinet, saxophone, chamber music and woodwind techniques. Pance began his formal musical studies under Manol Janev at the Music and Ballet High School *Ilija Nikolovski Luj* in the capital of Macedonia, Skopje. Undergraduate studies followed at the *Kiril I Metodij* University where he studied with Ivan Kocarov. Pance was awarded a Bachelor of Music degree from the Conservatory of Music at the University of the Pacific in Stockton, California, where he studied clarinet with Dr. Patricia Shands. He is currently a doctoral candidate at the University of Nebraska – Lincoln where he held a Graduate Teaching Assistantship for five years. His major teacher at UNL is Dr. Diane Barger.

Pance is a member of the Huntington Trio and performs with the Lincoln Symphony Orchestra and the Lincoln Municipal Band. His recent performances include a solo performance at the Midwest Clarifest at the University of Nebraska – Lincoln. Pance also enjoys playing Jazz and Blues and performs with Swing Fever, Skylark and Imprint.
