**SUU's ART INSIGHTS TO HOST
ANNETTE EVERETT, SCULPTOR
NOVEMBER 6, 2014**

SOUTHERN UTAH UNIVERSITY, Cedar City, Utah: Beginning with raw clay, **Annette Everett** carefully crafts meaningful three-dimensional compositions that are transformed into bronze sculpture. **SUU's Department of Art & Design** features Everett during its weekly series, **Art Insights**, in the **Sterling Church Auditorium** of **SUU's Sharwan Smith Center** on **Thursday, November 6, 2014** at **7pm**. **Admission is free and the general public is invited to attend.**

Versed in traditional clay and bronze sculpture work, **Annette Everett** dives into spiritual moments throughout her eloquent pieces. With the tools of symbolism, meaningful concepts, and fluid composition, Everett builds her artwork. In this presentation, Annette hopes to share and inspire through her work; she hopes to detail "From Beginning to End: Creating and Living with Art that You Love." Her guiding mantra is that sculpture art "begins with inspiration. From inspiration to concept. To design. To creation. To presentation. To home."

Everett enjoys honing her craft through workshops and teaching in her studio. Sharing a creative sanctuary with others led her to the establishment of BRUSHWORKS Fine Art Studio and Gallery in 1997. It became a classroom, a workshop, a clubhouse, and a home for many students and artists. In addition to her remarkable sculptures, Annette paints in pastel and oil, creating traditional and representational landscapes, portraits, and still life. Artistic passion has evolved since her youth, leading Annette to the study of art education at Brigham Young University (1968-1971), the University of Utah (1971-1972), and the Art Academy of Cincinnati (1985). Everett's knowledge and love for art has propelled her to create marvelous works for commission and exhibitions. ART INSIGHTS is a weekly program hosted during the fall and spring semesters by SUU's Art and Design faculty. Students and community members meet to experience presentations and discussions by
