**Braithwaite Fine Arts Gallery To Feature
The Stories We Could Tell,
Images and Stories from James Dalrymple
At the Hunter Conference Center
June 26-August 28, 2015**

Southern Utah University, Cedar City, Utah: They are the faces that haunt you and tell their own unique story that form the inspiration for author/photographer **James Dalrymple's** exhibition ***The Stories We Could Tell***. Opening at **5pm** on **Friday, June 26** at SUU's **Hunter Conference Center** and running through **August 28**, this exhibition is **free** and is open to the public **Monday through Friday, 10am-5pm**. The exhibition will also be open **Fridays June 26, July 31 and August 28** as part of the Cedar City Arts Council's Final Friday Art Walks.

With the eye of a photojournalist, James Dalrymple captures startling images that have called to the man behind the camera. Each image is accompanied by Dalrymple's own narrative about the subject and how the photo's subject spoke to him. The photographs offer an insightful retrospective of faces and places that have captured Dalrymple's imagination and vision. Quoting the author, "Words, pictures, music, stories. I feel this compelling drive to create, capture, record and share them. I've been at it for a while, yet, I've only scratched the surface. In the process I've learned much about my own inadequacies, and, even more about our humanity. There is so much to do and so many stories to tell."

James Dalrymple has written, produced, directed, shot and edited entertainment and documentary films, television commercials, videos and multi-media projects in over 60 countries. He is an award-winning photographer, has a Masters Degree in English Literature, has written a number of feature length screenplays, and has recently completed a novel length psychological thriller scheduled for publication in September.

The Stories We Could Tell runs in conjunction with the ***Southern Utah Art Invitational Exhibition & Sale*** at SUU's Braithwaite Fine Arts Gallery. Featuring the dazzling work of 40 of the region's most gifted artists, the show runs through August 29. Hours are Monday through Saturday, 10am until 8pm. The show is free and the general public encouraged to attend.
