**SUU's DEPARTMENT OF MUSIC PRESENTS**  
**PIANIST IAN MOSCHENROSS**  
**PERFORMING MUSIC OF MOZART AND CHOPIN**  
**OCTOBER 22, 2015**

**Southern Utah University, Cedar City, Utah:** Exquisite music by Mozart, Chopin and Liszt will be heard when pianist **Ian Moschenross** performs in a free recital presented by **Southern Utah University's Department of Music**. The recital starts at **7:30pm** on **Thursday, October 22** in **Thorley Recital Hall** within SUU's Music Building. The performance is open to the public.

For his recital, Moschenross has selected a program featuring classical piano music by the masters. The performance includes "Danza de la Pastora" (Dance of the Shepherdess) from *Sonatina* (1927) by Ernesto Halffter (1905-1989), "Sonata in C Major, K. 330" (1783) by Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart (1756-1791), and "Valse-Caprice No. 6 in A Minor, S. 427" from *Soirées de Vienne* (1852) arranged by Franz Liszt (1811-1886) after Franz Schubert (1797-1827) with an alternate ending by Vladimir Horowitz (1903-1989). The program also features performances of "Valse brillante in A-flat Major, Op. 34, No. 1" (1835) by Frederic Chopin (1810-1849), "Arabeske, Op. 18" (1839) by Robert Schumann (1810-1856), "La Plus que Lente (Valse)" (1910) by Claude Debussy (1862-1918), "Trois Esquisses de danses modernes" (Three Sketches of Modern Dances) (1927) by Bohuslav Martinů (1890-1959), and "Danzas Argentinas" (1939) by Alberto Ginastera (1916-1983).

A versatile pianist, **Ian Moschenross** is an active recitalist, chamber musician and accompanist. In addition to performing and adjudicating, he teaches applied piano, music history, theory, appreciation and interdisciplinary courses at Monmouth College, where he has served on the faculty since 2004 and holds the rank of Associate Professor of Music. He chaired the Monmouth College Music Department from 2005-2011. A member of the Illinois Music Teachers Association, Moschenross is a past executive board

member and past treasurer. Dr. Moschenross earned degrees from Hanover College and the University of Nebraska-Lincoln, where he studied with Dr. C. Kimm Hollis and Dr. Mark Clinton, respectively.
