Photography Trendsetter, Chris McCaw to Present at SUU

Southern Utah University, Cedar City, Utah: Chris McCaw started out like any other teenage kid, his mother forced him to take a class that he didn't want to take. The rarity in this case is that McCaw became instantly hooked to photography and has pioneered his own creative way through the lens of his camera. Hear him tell his story at Art Insights on Thursday, March 31, at 7 p.m. in the Auditorium Theatre. This presentation is open to the community and free of charge.

A native Californian, McCaw spent his time among the punk and skateboarding scenes. He took the motto of those "DIY" cultures and applied that to his work in photography. He built his first camera in 1995, a 7 x 17" view camera to make contact negatives for platinum prints. This paved the way for his Sunburn project and his revolutionary work in the field of photography.

McCaw's photography has been viewed in many public and private collections throughout the country from the West coast to the East coast. Collections include the New York Metropolitan Museum of Art, the National Gallery of Art in Washington DC, and the Museum of Photographic Arts in San Diego, California.

Being featured in publications and receiving various awards, McCaw's work should not be missed. His most recent accomplishments include the Emerging Icon in Photography award in 2014 from the George Eastman House International Museum of Photography and Film as well as his most recent solo exhibition at Yossi Milo Gallery in New York which opened this March.

Art Insights is a weekly program hosted during the fall and spring semesters by SUU's Art and Design faculty. Students and community members meet to experience presentations and discussions by visiting artists and art educators from around the nation who share their work and insights. Admission is free, and the general public is invited to attend.
