Project Summary

I created and led the “Hire One More” project. This project was designed to inform local business of Emery County of the benefits that come to the community by hiring one more employee.

I designed a handout explaining how business can be eligible for various back to Work incentives. Incentives such as wage subsidy of up to \$2,000 per eligible participant, On-The-Job-Training, Federal Work Opportunity Tax Credit and many other compensation and credits offered by the federal government.

Project Highlights

I set a goal to visit with 150 businesses about the “Hire One More” project. The total number I visited came to 165. I mailed 245 flyers to the remaining businesses in Emery County for a total of 410 flyers being distributed.
