

FACULTY/STAFF INCENTIVE TO STUDY ABROAD



The Office of Learning Abroad wants to reward SUU faculty and staff who encourage students to study abroad.

Here's how:

When students apply for a study abroad program that offers at least 3 course credits, they are asked to list one or two faculty or staff who encouraged them to participate. After the student has completed a study abroad program, the faculty or staff member(s) will receive a point (or half-point, if two are listed) towards a trip of their own. Faculty and staff members can also choose to have their points converted to a study abroad scholarship.

HOW TO EARN POINTS

Faculty and staff who have earned:

1-4 points: are acknowledged on the OLA website

5-9 points: receive a \$500 stipend to travel on behalf of OLA (perhaps to conduct research for a future study abroad program or to add a short visit to an overseas trip paid for with other funds, etc.)

10-14 points: receive a \$1,100 stipend to travel on behalf of OLA

15+ points: receive a 5-day, all-expenses-paid trip to visit one of SUU's partner universities (or a \$1,800 stipend to travel on other OLA-related business)
