



**SB #23/24-15: CECS Christmas Party Funding Bill**

*Be it enacted by the SUUSA Student Senate assembled:*

1. *Section 1: Purpose:*
  - a. This bill aims to allocate funds for the College of Engineering and Computational Sciences' Christmas party on December 7, 2023 to procure necessary supplies for the event.
2. *Section 2: The Senate finds that:*
  - a. Providing funding to the College of Engineering and Computational Sciences for the above purpose would be in the best interest in promoting a student event in which all students are welcome.
  - b. Said event would serve as an opportunity for relaxation for students before semester finals and a chance for students to find or form study groups ahead of the following week's exams.
3. *Section 3: Action 1:*
  - a. In accordance with the purpose stated, the Student Senate allocates \$500 to the College of Engineering and Computational Sciences for the

procurement of party supplies, including plastic wares and construction materials for the gingerbread house activity.

4. *Section 4: Action 2:*

- a. Following the conclusion of the above party, a report will be compiled to provide an overview of the event's success, highlights, and participant feedback.
- b. McKay Fawcett, the Engineering and Computational Sciences Senator, or their designee, shall be in charge of delivering a report to the Student Senate at its next scheduled session.
- c. An itemized list of items purchased for the use of the event shall be included as part of the report found in the above subsection.
- d. Any unused portion of the above funds shall be returned to the Student Senate budget.
- e. Efforts shall be made to market the above event to the entire student body.

5. *Section 5: Definitions:*

- a. **Plastic Wares:** Includes plates, foam cups, napkins, and silverware used during the party. It may also include plastic tablecloths.
- b. **Construction Materials:** Materials required for building gingerbread houses such as Graham crackers, frosting, and candy used during the event.

6. *Section 6:* This legislation shall take effect immediately.
