2024 Scholarship Application Instructions

The Cedar City Chapter of the Sons of Utah Pioneers will award scholarships varying from \$500 to \$2,000 according to the number of scholarships awarded and compatibility to Sons of Utah Pioneer's mission.

1. Attend an Iron County area school: i.e., Canyon View High School, Cedar City High School, Parowan High School, a charter school, or a home school in Iron County.
2. Be admitted to an institution of higher learning that matches and supports the educational goals of the applicant.
3. Submit one letter of recommendation from a family member demonstrating character and service to family or community. (Grandparent, parent, guardian, uncle or aunt)
4. Submit two letters from nonrelatives demonstrating outstanding character, service and scholarship.
5. Submit self description of evidence of community and school service.
6. Write and submit an essay with maximum of six hundred words, of a historical person, event or ancestor that has impacted Utah.
7. If the winning applicant plans to serve a mission, enter military service, or delay entering college for another SUP board-approved reason, the scholarship will be held for a maximum of two years.
8. Scholarship recipients will be asked to make a short presentation to SUP members during or following their first year of higher education.
9. Applications must include a self-introductory letter that includes applicant's permanent contact information: address, phone number, and email address.
