Talent Search Objectives

PERSISTENCE

80% of non-senior participants will complete the current academic year and continue in school for the next academic year, at the next grade level.

GRADUATION

85% of seniors will graduate with a regular secondary school diploma

GRADUATION WITH RIGOR

20% of seniors will graduate having completed a rigorous program of study

POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION ENROLLMENT

65% of seniors will enroll in an institution of higher education in the fall

Attainment of Objectives

100% (537/537) ETS students persisted to the next academic year at the next grade level

100% (98/98) ETS seniors graduated ontime

28% (23/82) ETS seniors graduated on – time AND completed a program of rigor

83% (68/82) ETS seniors enrolled into a postsecondary institution Fall 2013.
